Login to QNAP.

- 1. Look for Backup Station (2 ways)
 - a. On the QNAP Desktop
 - b. Menu button on top left.
- 2. Click on Backup Station.



- 3. Once you are in the Backup Station, it will show the setup page that you will need.
- 4. You will only need to enable the following options.
 - a. Port Number should be a default of 873
 - b. "Enable backup from a remote server to the local host" should be ticked.
 - c. "Allow remote Rsync server to back up data to NAS" should be ticked.
 - i. Username
 - ii. Password
- 5. Click Apply.
